     (OntologySummit, OKMDS, SemanticWiki, EarthScienceOntolog, ...)
  - projects and initiatives that we have spun-off or incubated (OOR, QUOMOS, OntologPSMW ...)
  - people/work we support/co-locate with (IAOA, SOCoP, OntoIOp, CLv2, ...)
- the Body-of-Knowledge (BOK) this community has collectively built (since Apr. 2002)
