Who are we making our case to?


- Policy Makers ... to put us on the map

Why does it still feel like we are at a loss?

... remembering that the Dartmouth Summer Research Conference on Artificial Intelligence actually took place in 1956 ...



- Hasn't this taken a bit too long?
- I believe Thomas Kuhn has our answer, in “The Structure of Scientific Revolutions” (1962, with his 1969 postscript)
- Ontology is still at Kuhn's “pre-paradigm” phase
