My Current Assessment

- Ontology development is at the Craft stage
 - Everyone rolls their own
 - There is very little reuse vs reinvention
 - There are no widely used standard ontologies
- There is little understanding of
 - How different ontologies for the same thing relate to each other
 - How to map between different ontologies
 - How to construct ontologies from components

Some Critical Success Factors

- We need to be able to understand how different ontologies based on different commitments relate to each other
- We need to be able to decompose and reconstruct theories so that
 - We can see the components that ontologies use,
 - reuse and extension can be deliberate and integrated rather than copy and change

Why the SIO initiative

- The Lattice of Theories that John Sowa has talked about has the potential to address many of the problems
- COLORE seems to be at least a step down the path of taking this approach
- I have not seen an alternative that is capable of addressing the issues at hand
